Visit the tallest temple in America

Temple IV or Temple of the Two-headed Serpent is located in Complex N, in the ruins of Tikal in the department of Petén. This is the fourth main temple of the Acropolis and recognized as the highest in the entire American continent.

Temple IV: It is located in the West area with a view of the Plaza Mayor. This Mayan construction has a height of about 70 meters from the ground to its crest. It is also the largest temple in Tikal, not only because of its height but also because of its volume, which is approximately 191,139 cubic meters. It is believed that this compound was built during the reign of Yik'in Chan Ka'wil, son of Hasaw Cha'an Kawil. An important part of this construction was embodied in the lintels. This is due to the fact that the wars and feats of this ruler were engraved on them.
